Throughout the week there will be dialogue with staff and guest speakers...while enjoying the great outdoors and summer camp fun!

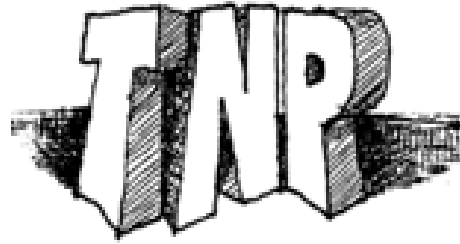
